

The Dominican Republic's Declaration of Commitment for the Transformation of Education:

The government of the Dominican Republic recognizes that in order to achieve a better quality of life for its citizens, the highest rates of economic, political, and social development will be attained by educating the Dominican people.

Through the Ministry of Education, the Dominican Republic's central government is focused on improving the quality of Dominican education by embarking on a new student-centered educational model called "Education for a better life", which will provide students with the knowledge that is relevant to their lives, so that they may graduate and enter the labor market as competitive citizens, and as citizens who can easily fit into the type of society that the world demands of us in order to achieve the highest levels of development, which is in everyone's interest.

Following a national consultation, we have another input that will enhance the information that is needed for creating public policies that will have an impact on the quality of education in general, as well as on the specific situations and conditions of each region in our country.

The Dominican Republic, through the Ministry of Education, developed public policies that saved the school year during the pandemic, through the "Education for All, Preserving Health" program with remote learning, implementing actions such as teaching via television, radio, and electronic devices, synchronously and asynchronously, which enabled the school year to continue during this turbulent time.

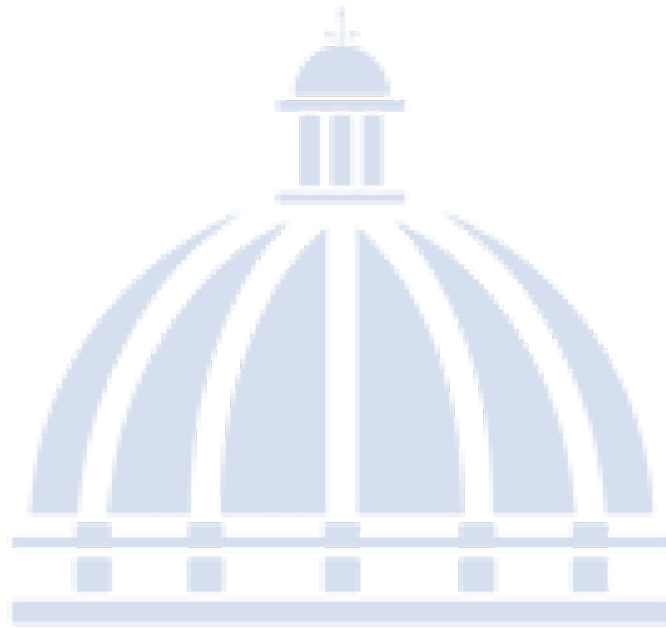
Although on the whole, the nation has overcome Covid-19, the government of the Dominican Republic remains committed to ensuring that all children and adolescents get an education and that no one is left out.
